Preparation List for Flea Service

Certain preparations are necessary to guarantee the effectiveness of your flea service. These steps Must be completed **prior** to your service appointment. The service technician can not do the service properly unless these steps are completed. **All of the following preparations are necessary for the treatment to be effective.** Please call our office if you have any questions regarding these instructions.

BEFORE SERVICE:

1. Remove any pets from residence. Fish and Reptiles are especially at risk, if you cannot move them, then you must cover the aquarium. *The cover needs to be airtight.*
2. A veterinarian must give your pet(s) a flea treatment on day of service. You will need the receipt for your service guarantee*.
3. Turn off gas to stove.
4. Move as much as possible off the floor and from underneath beds *especially in your pet's favorite areas.*
5. Vacuum your entire residence especially under furniture. Remove vacuum bags or empty canisters into a trash bag and dispose of it in a receptacle **OUTSIDE** of the building. If you live in an apartment, Please Do Not Throw The Bag Into The Trash Chutes!
6. Put all open food and anything that goes in the mouth (tobacco products, medications, toothbrushes, bottles & pacifiers etc.) in airtight containers (cabinets are not airtight).
7. Remove window air conditioners or cover them with plastic.
8. All persons, excluding the pest control technician, MUST leave the home before service can begin.

The residence must be vacant for 4-6 hours after the treatment!

AFTER SERVICE:

9. Wash all dishes and utensils before use.
10. Launder all bedding and clothes and pet bedding in hot water. Make sure they are put in the dryer for at least 40 minutes.
11. Any pet and/or infant toys and dishes *should* be washed before being used again.
12. Vacuum after reentering and dispose of the vacuum bag in a receptacle outside of the building.
13. It can take up to 14 days to see the full effect of the treatment, if you are still experiencing a problem **AFTER** 14 days please contact our office.

Price will be determined only upon inspection. Once service has been scheduled a \$50.00 fee will be applied to your account for any cancellation of your appointment unless our office is notified 24 hours before the scheduled appointment.

* This service carries a 30 day guarantee valid only if all the above steps were completed and there is a receipt showing your pet(s) were treated for fleas by a veterinarian on the same day you had service.
